**President remarks:**

Welcome to the new and returning LPCC Board Members following the Annual Meeting. After several years of managing COVID protocols and this past season with the World University Games and a very limited ice availability, this season is expected to be one with curling from mid-Oct to mid-March. Three cheers!

LPCC will enjoy curling in the newly expanded Civic Center following the \$7 million upgrades surrounding the Games. However, with the expansion and upgraded facilities, we anticipate some new rules / new fees. More to come on that piece. Kim is in touch with Matt Wolter of the Civic Center, and the Civic Center Board is voting on ice time, general facility fees and cost structures.

**Financials:**

**Membership:**

- Expected for upcoming season: 40-50 LPCC Members
- LPCC reached 50 members following the University Games, it is expected not all will renew, given time commitments for the full season

**Season Structure**

**The Board discussed and agreed:**

- 2 seasons of League curling; Oct - Jan; Jan - March
  - 2 teams - can do ½ season and can join at the season break;

- Curl with increased mix of LPCC Members
- Wednesdays in Oct & March are possible; Civic Center is confirming
- Possibilities to curl at slightly discounted rates during the school day / 'dead ice time'
- Membership fee TBD; most likely ~ \$295
  - Covers anticipated hourly ice rate of ~\$225; insurance; GNCC membership
  - Split Season one season only would be higher than half ~ \$185
- Subs = Flat fee overall ~ \$150
  - Subs in the past gave inconsistent payments if weekly charges / Board agreed not to charge per week

  - Civic Center relays this is similar to 'first year' of new facility
